- \* Identify and designate responsible person(s) at pre-decided levels of hierarchy and the cross-functional agencies for ensuring adherence to this policy and compliance with environmental Laws and Regulations.
- \* Provide adequate engineered features in design of NPPs on environmental safety aspects.
- \* Adopt adequate defense- in- depth approach in design, construction, commissioning, operation and decommissioning of NPPs to minimize environmental impact to As Low As Reasonably Achievable (ALARA).
- \* Reduce generation of wastes at source to As Low As Reasonably Achievable (ALARA) and dispose inevitable wastes in environmentally acceptable manner within the applicable regulatory limits.
- \* Conserve key resources / raw material viz water, oil and energy by optimizing their use.
