1. ABOUT NPCIL:

Nuclear Power Corporation of India Limited (NPCIL) is a Public Sector Enterprise under the administrative control of the **Department of Atomic Energy (DAE)**, Government of India. The Company was registered as a Public Limited Company under the Companies Act, 1956 in September 1987 with the objectives of operating atomic power plants and implementing atomic power projects for generation of electricity in pursuance of the schemes and programmes of the Government of India under the Atomic Energy Act, 1962.

NPCIL is responsible for design, construction, commissioning and operation of nuclear power reactors. NPCIL is a MoU signing, profit making and dividend paying company with the highest level of credit rating (AAA rating by CRISIL and CARE). NPCIL is presently operating 24 commercial nuclear power reactors with an installed capacity of 8880 MW. NPCIL has 7 more reactors under various stages of construction with a total capacity of 6100 MW. In addition to these, Government of India have accorded administrative approval and financial sanction for ten PHWR units to be set up in fleet mode with unit size of 700 MW each.

Pre-project activities at new sites, which were accorded 'in principle' approval by the Government of India, have been initiated so as to enable early launch of projects at these sites. Being a responsible corporate citizen, NPCIL accomplishes CSR activities and implements projects related to Sustainable Development (SD). The company is in compliance to Corporate Governance as per guidelines issued by Department of Public Enterprises (DPE).

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2. ABOUT PROCUREMENT ACTIVITIES OF NPCIL:

The Procurement activities at NPCIL play an important role to ensure proper upkeep of its assets and meeting the requirement of Stations and Projects. NPCIL issues tenders having scope of work viz. supply / service / works (both supply & service included) / EPC. In these tenders, the documents submitted by Bidders are evaluated w.r.t Qualifying Requirements (QR) criteria stipulated in the Bidding Documents.

For all the tenders issued by NPCIL with effect from 01.01.2025, it was decided that bidders who wish to participate in tenders of NPCIL shall be required to submit all the documents, in support of QR (such as copy of Purchase Orders / Work Orders / Contract Agreements, Client Certificates, CA Certificates etc.) duly certified and verified for authenticity from Independent Statutory Auditor of their Company or specified Third-Party Inspection Agency (TPIA). The Bidder who wish to participate in tenders of NPCIL shall be required to submit duly certified and verified documents from specified TPIA in support of meeting QR along with a certificate regarding verification of authenticity of documents as per the format placed at **Annexure-I**. All the documents submitted by the bidder in support of meeting QR shall be **digitally signed** by specified TPIA so that the authenticity of such documents certified could be validated by NPCIL through appropriate digital signature reading software. Currently, there are about 26 TPIAs under “NPCIL acceptable list of TPIAs” that had given consent for their inclusion based on the LoA issued by NPCIL.

This EOI is issued to solicit responses from all the eligible TPIAs (as per “Selection methodology” clause in Section-I) for their inclusion in the forthcoming tenders of NPCIL. The agencies that were in the earlier approved list shall have to apply afresh to be considered for inclusion in the NPCIL acceptable list of TPIAs. It may be noted that any cost incurred in authentication of veracity of documents shall be borne by the Bidder and NPCIL shall have no liability (financial or otherwise) towards the same.

3. ABOUT EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) - SCOPE OF WORK & SELECTION METHODOLOGY:

SCOPE OF WORK:

- NPCIL intends to enlist Third-Party Inspection Agencies (TPIA) for the examination, certification, verification for authenticity of the documents submitted by various bidders in NPCIL tenders.
- The bidder(s) who wish to participate in the tenders floated by NPCIL are required to submit all the documents in support of Qualifying Requirements (QR) (such as copy of Purchase Orders / Work Orders / Contract Agreements, Client Certificates, CA Certificates etc.) duly certified and verified for authenticity from Independent Statutory Auditor of their Company or specified Third-Party Inspection Agency (TPIA).
- The TPIAs to be enlisted are required to examine all the documents in support of QR to verify the authenticity of the same. The TPIAs must certify their work by means of submission of the certificate/undertaking as per the format placed at Annexure-1. All the documents submitted by TPIAs to NPCIL should be duly digitally signed by the authorized signatory of the TPIA.

EOI SELECTION METHODOLOGY:

All the TPIA applicants who participate in this EOI and are NABCB accredited Inspection bodies who have been accredited as per the requirement of ISO/IEC 17020 as Type 'A' only in QCI's NABCB website (<https://nabcb.qci.org.in/inspection-body/>), shall be included in the list of Acceptable TPIA in tenders floated by NPCIL.

MANNER AND METHOD FOR SUBMISSION OF RESPONSES TO EOI:

Eligible Applicants who meet the above selection methodology are requested to submit Expression of Interest (EOI) for inclusion in the list of acceptable TPIA agencies of NPCIL. The documents to be submitted by eligible applicants for inclusion in the list of acceptable TPIA agencies:

- i. Application Form (refer **Section-III**) duly **digitally** signed by authorized signatory along with PoA of the signatory

- ii. Documentary proof (**duly digitally signed by authorized signatory**) to establish that Inspection Body has been accredited by NABCB as per the requirement of ISO/IEC 17020 as Type A.

The responses to EOI shall be made by the applicant through CPPP portal only and any other mode of submission of response will be summarily rejected. Those applicants that are not registered with CPPP are requested to get enrolled in CPPP portal as specified in Para 4, Section – II of this EOI. No deviation in the response to EOI submitted by eligible applicants shall be accepted and any such deviation(s) found in the response submitted is liable for rejection.

ENLISTMENT OF TPIA AS ACCEPTABLE TPIA IN TENDERS FLOATED BY NPCIL

The eligible TPIAs that are shortlisted as per the selection methodology shall be communicated separately regarding their enlistment in the NPCIL list of acceptable TPIAs. The enlistment period of the NPCIL list of acceptable TPIAs shall be for the period of three (03) years from the date of notification to TPIA.

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Section-II: Instructions to the Applicants

1. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- a) Language of the responses to EOI or any query/ clarifications/correspondences shall be in English only.
- b) For Expression of Interest, Application Form and Annexures shall be duly filled and submitted as per provisions mentioned under “Submission of EOI” clause of this Section-II by the applicant in soft copy only.
- c) Applicant shall mention the name and contact details with complete address, phone number and email id.
- d) NPCIL may, at its sole discretion, ask for additional information/documents and/ or seek clarifications from the applicant (s) after the deadline for submission of a response, inter alia, for the purpose of removal of inconsistencies or infirmities in their responses.
- e) NPCIL reserves the rights of getting the documents cross verified from the documents issuing authority.
- f) NPCIL reserves the right to call upon the applicant to produce original(s) of all the documents submitted against response to EOI for verification at any stage. If the same are not produced in stipulated time, the request of applicant for inclusion in the list of acceptable TPIA agencies will be rejected.

2. CORRIGENDUM:

At any time before the last date of submission of EOI, NPCIL may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by an applicant, modify the EOI document. The amendment/addendum/corrigendum will be posted on CPPP portal only and will be binding on the applicant (s) and the applicant will give due consideration to the same, while they submit their EOIs, and would invariably enclose documents/ information, as required, on account of the amendment, as a part of the EOI. NPCIL may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of EOIs.

3. DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED:

EOI to be submitted by Applicant(s) shall consist of the following:

- (i) Application Form (refer **Section-III**) duly **digitally** signed by authorized Signatory along with PoA of the signatory.
- (ii) Documentary proof (**duly digitally signed by authorized signatory**) to establish that Inspection Body has been accredited by NABCB as per the requirement of ISO/IEC 17020 as Type 'A'.

4. SUBMISSION OF EOI IN CPPP:

Applicants are required to submit their Application complete in all respects, for the subject EOI through CPP portal (<https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app>) only. Applicants shall upload the EOI Application, complete in all respects, in Tender ID NPCIL/CMM/TPIA/2025 under 'Fee/ PreQual / Technical /Finance' Cover at the CPPP (<https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app>). The EOI Application uploaded on the e-tender Portal shall be digitally signed using Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) key of Class 3 by a duly authorized representative of the Applicant. The Applicants can enroll themselves on the CPPP (<https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app>) using the "Online Bidder Enrollment" tab. The use of Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) key is mandatory for submission of EOI. Accordingly, bidders should have Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) key of Class 3 to participate in the EOI. Applicants, if required, can obtain digital signature certificate (DSC) Key of Class 3 as per Indian IT Act from the licensed Certifying Authorities (CA) operating under the Root Certifying Authority of India (RCAI) namely Controller of Certifying Authorities (CCA) of India.. The said portal also has the user manuals with detailed guidelines for enrollment on the portal and participation in the EOI.

EOI Application should be duly **digitally** signed by the authorized signatory in whose favor the Power of Attorney is issued.

NPCIL reserves the right to reject or accept any or all applications, cancel/withdraw the EOI process without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case, the APPLICANT shall not have any claim arising out of such action. NPCIL bears no responsibility or liability of any kind in reference to this EOI.

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5. RESPONSIVENESS CHECK OF EOI:

Responses shall be deemed non-responsive for the following reasons:

- a) Responses that are incomplete, i.e., not accompanied by any of the applicable formats inter alia Application Form, power of attorney, supporting documents, provided in Section-III;
- b) Responses not signed by authorized signatory in the manner indicated in this EOI;
- c) Material inconsistencies in the information/ documents submitted by the Applicant
- d) Response being conditional in nature;
- e) Response not received by the EOI Deadline;
- f) Applicant delaying in the submission of additional information or clarifications sought by NPCIL, as applicable;

All applications that shall meet the responsive check requirements set out above in this section of the EOI document shall be considered as responsive. In case of non-submission of relevant details as above, the responses may be considered as “Non-responsive”, at the sole discretion of NPCIL and will not be considered further.

6. COSTS AND EXPENSES TOWARDS RESPONSE TO EOI

The Applicants shall be responsible for all the costs associated with the preparation of the response and participation in discussions related with this EOI.

NPCIL shall not be responsible in any way for such costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of this short-listing/ selection process.

7. SUSPENSION, CANCELLATION OF ENLISTMENT

7.0 Banning of business dealings by NPCIL/Buyer

NPCIL reserves the right to initiate Banning as per NPCIL’s Banning of business dealings as mentioned below.

The words banning, blacklisting, de-registered, debarred, holiday, suspension of business etc., means the same.

The words NPCIL, Corporation, Buyer etc., means the same.

The words Applicant, TPIA etc. means the same.

7.1 Grounds for Banning

Expression of Interest (EOI) from NABCB accredited Inspection Bodies for getting listed as Acceptable Third Party Inspection Agency (TPIA) in tenders floated by NPCIL (EOI Ref. no. **NPCIL/CMM/TPIA/2025 Date: 10.10.2025**)

The business dealing with the Applicant / TPIA shall be liable for banning, on account of the reasons attributable to them, which shall include, but not limited to the following:

Baseless allegations by the Applicant / TPIA on NPCIL/Corporation/Buyer evaluation processes or officials.

If any of the owner, proprietor or partner of the Applicant/TPIA, is convicted by a court of law, during EOI invitation and evaluation process or enlistment period of the TPIA, for offences involving corrupt and fraudulent practices including misrepresentation of the facts, moral turpitude in relation to its business dealings with NPCIL.

If any of the owner, proprietor or partner of the Applicant/TPIA is found to be involved in any malafide / unlawful acts / malpractices or improper conduct during the process of document verification in their enlistment period.

Submission of responses to EOI that contain false information or falsified documents or the concealment of such information in the EOI in order to influence the outcome of eligibility screening or / at any other stage of the EOI and enlistment.

Bidder shall not act in contravention of the codes which includes

7.2 Prohibition of

- a. Making offer, solicitation or acceptance of bribe, reward or gift or any material benefit, either directly or indirectly, in exchange for an unfair advantage in the enlistment process or to otherwise influence the EOI evaluation process.
- b. Any conclusion that may impair the transparency, fairness and the progress of the enlistment process.
- c. Improper use of information provided by the procuring entity to the applicant/TPIA with an intent to gain unfair advantage in the enlistment process or for personal gain.
- d. Any malpractice or unlawful act / behaviour in the document verification and authentication process adopted by the TPIA **with any of the bidder(s) participating in the tenders floated by NPCIL during the enlistment period.**
- e. Obstruction of any investigation or auditing during enlistment period.
- f. **Making false declaration or providing false undertaking/certification against any of the documents submitted for verification by the bidder(s) participating in the tenders floated by NPCIL.**

7.3 Show Cause Notice

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NPCIL will issue Show Cause Notice to the Applicant / TPIA on noticing/receipt of a complaint of any irregularities and /or misconduct and /or unethical practice as mentioned in clause no. 7.1 & 7.2.

Upon receipt of Show cause notice, the Applicant / TPIA is required to submit the reply to Show Cause Notice within 30 days of its receipt and no extension shall be given without justifiable reasons. The Applicant / TPIA shall also be given an opportunity for oral hearing to present the case in person to NPCIL and the date of Oral Hearing will be indicated in the Show Cause Notice. Only the regular employees of Applicant / TPIA will be permitted to represent the Applicant / TPIA during the Oral hearing, and no outsider shall be allowed to represent the Applicant / TPIA on their behalf.

7.4 Period of Banning

The period of banning shall be for a period of not exceeding 2 (two) years and not less than 6 (six) months as considered appropriate by NPCIL.

7.5 Effect of Banning of Business Dealings by NPCIL

In case NPCIL has banned the business dealing with the Applicant / TPIA, the enlistment of the TPIA/Applicant shall cease to exist. The TPIA who has been enlisted in the list of acceptable TPIA agencies of NPCIL, shall not be permitted to certify /verify the documents submitted by the bidders in tenders floated by NPCIL and they will be removed from the acceptable TPIA list of NPCIL.

Banning in any manner does not impact any other contractual or other legal rights of NPCIL. Banning under the provisions of Banning of Business Dealings of NPCIL is applicable only for NPCIL.
