Activities carried out under Category A for the month of February, 2022

1. A special webinar on 'Road to Success – Accountability to Ownership' was arranged at the KAPS Site showcasing the journey of NPCIL and the progress in the field of peaceful uses of atomic energy since independence. It was delivered by Site Director, KAPS, Shri M. Venkatachalam for the benefit of the employees of KAPS, NPCIL.
2. NPCIL's Chutka Site participated in 'Vigyan Sarvatra Pujyate' and 'Science Week' event organized by the Gol at Vigyan Bhavan, New Delhi under the celebrations of the 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsava'. About 500 people visited NPCIL's exhibit during the event.
3. To celebrate Indian Independence and highlight the contributions of Atomic Energy in the development of the nation as Aatmanirbhar Bharat, the model of the 700 MWe indigenously designed Pressurized Heavy Water Reactor was handed over to the Karwar Science Center and installed in the nuclear miniature gallery made by NPCIL at the Science Center. The model was handed over by Station Director, KGS Shri R.K.Gupta to the Director, Karwar Science Centre Shri Sanjeev Deshpande.
4. In order to commemorate the celebrations, special articles are being published by NPCIL in scientific and management magazines which have a wide outreach. Under this initiative, **Atom's Energy can keep the world powered and the Nature calm** was published in Scientific India magazine print edition, Jan-Feb 2022 issue.
5. Many competitions were organized for the employees of NPCIL and their family members specially to celebrate Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsava. Among them were the Quiz organized for the students at the KGS Site and for the teachers at the KAPS Site and the Rangoli Competition for the family members of the employees by the IBS Nature Club at the Kakrapara Site.
6. In order to celebrate 75 years of Indian Independence, various webinar series were organized for different strata of people in the society by various sites as well as NPCIL HQs to make the people aware about the journey of NPCIL and its contribution in the development of the nation.
7. On the occasion of Science Day, various talks were organized on virtual platforms to address the students and teachers via various science centres including the Nehru Science Center, the Goa Science Center, District Science Centre, Kalaburagi and the Regional Science Centre, Lucknow.
8. A total of 51 outreach programs were organized during the month, comprising of 34 site visits and 15 lectures (including online / webinars) imparting awareness to 61,780 in February.
