## 1.0 Introduction

NPCIL has been implementing Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) projects since its inception as per the commitment to economic and social development of the community living around 16 Km radius from all its Units. CSR programme is generally implemented as per the identified need of the community. The thrust areas for CSR programme are: education, healthcare, infrastructure development, skill development, and sustainable development.

With the Companies Act 2013, making CSR mandatory for the eligible companies, the CSR programme has been strengthened since FY 2017-18 with further delegation of financial powers for speedy implementation. A two tier structure comprising the Unit CSR Cell and Site Level Committee manages the CSR projects at the sites. At Headquarters, the Tier II Committee and the Board Sub-Committee on CSR and Sustainability steer the corporate CSR programme.

## 2.0 CSR Programme

As per the Section 135 of Companies Act 2013 and CSR Rules, NPCIL Board allocated ₹146.62 Crore for implementation of CSR Activities and NPCIL has spent ₹154.70 Crore during the FY 2025-26. The spending was done in total 86 new projects and 146 on-going projects in nine categories. The amount spent is more than the prescribed amount and there is no unspent CSR amount for FY 2025-26. Total number of new CSR projects initiated this year in different categories at the Units of NPCIL is given in the table below. It may be noted that expenditure was incurred only in 86 out of 126 new projects.

## 2.1 Thrust areas for CSR projects

The thrust areas for CSR projects are: education, healthcare, infrastructure development, skill development and sustainable development.

Thrust area as per the DPE Guidelines received from time to time are; i) to carryout spending in the Aspirational Districts and ii) DPE theme on Health and Nutrition for year 2025-26.

**2.1.1** Under education category the projects like construction of school buildings, school building for differently abled students, class rooms, Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) lab., astronomical lab., establishment of smart classes, furniture for schools, deployment of teachers in schools, organising coaching classes, improvement in learning outcome through various technological interventions, implementing PM internship scheme, training and education to children with special need; assistance to schools by providing drinking water, toilets, multi-purpose hall, library, boundary wall, prayer stage, flooring, basket ball court, white and green boards, LCD TV and smart TVs; assistance to students by providing cycles, books, school kits, uniforms, scholarship, one time award etc. were taken up during this year.

**2.1.2** Under healthcare, the CSR projects included running of primary health centre and OPD services at Tarapur Maharashtra Site, Narora Atomic Power Station, Kakrapar Gujarat Site and Kaiga Generating Station; providing mobile medical van services at Kakrapar Gujarat Site, Kaiga Generating Station, Kudankulam Nuclear Power Project, Gorakhpur Haryana Anu Vidyut Pariyojana and Chutka Madhya Pradesh Atomic Power Project; organising medical, special health care camps and eye camps for general public & students; construction of new Health sub centre, upgradation of outpatient (OP) ward building, maternity ward, patient shed building, ambulance etc. for Primary Health Centres (PHCs),

medical equipment for medical colleges and hospitals, dialysis machines and generator building for hospital, supply of medical kits, mission to end TB; providing assistive devices to differently abled persons for students and senior citizens and nutrition supplementation, development of aganwadis, kitchen shed, mid-day meal shed, supply of garbage collection and other cleaning equipment, toilets, providing T shirts of assorted sizes on Yoga day celebration, development of drinking water facility, laying of pipe lines, intake well, erection of pump house and water treatment plant, providing new bore well and motor, installation of RO Plant, water filters and coolers etc. Contribution was also made to Tata Memorial Centre, Mumbai and Madan Mohan Malviya Cancer Centre & Homi Bhabha Cancer Hospital, Varanasi and Homi Bhabha Cancer Hospital & Research Centre, Muzaffarpur for the purchase of equipment.

**2.1.3** Skill development initiatives were undertaken to ensure income generation for unemployed adults. Skills in tailoring, computers, CNC machines, plastic moulding, fashion designing, assistant electrician, welding, fitter, machinist, turner, tool and die maker, agriculture, cattle farming, dairy farming, engagement of trade apprentices etc. were focussed upon.

Tarapur Maharashtra Site implemented AKRUTI (Advance Knowledge & Rural Technology Implementation) project at Boisar. This aims to create awareness about technologies developed by BARC and other DAE units and propagate different technologies for rural development and entrepreneurship development in nearby villages. These technologies are rapid bio composting, fish processing, soil carbon detection techniques, tele ECG, infra-red dryer, water purifiers, neem biopesticide, seed multiplication etc.

**2.1.4** Under infrastructure development, the projects like laying of bituminous and concrete roads with drains, paver blocks, road solarisation, footpath and levelling, construction of bridge and foot bridges, construction of community hall, concrete benches at various schools, gardens, bus stops and crematoriums, construction of water tanks, bus stops and crematoriums and lift irrigation facilities, check dams, infrastructure facilities for promoting sports, procurement of JCB vehicles for water body maintenance, compound wall and store room, providing additional welfare facilities to Backward boys hostel and land side facilities at fishing village, providing bus facility for villagers, development of Astro Turf hockey ground, playground, construction of Gym hall with equipments, sports equipment hall in district stadium premises etc. were taken up.

**2.1.5** Some sustainable development initiatives were also undertaken this year. These included projects like rainwater harvesting, ground/ underground natural water bodies, irrigation system, ponds, solar street lights, solar power plants, agricultural projects, preparation of canvas bags to make area polythene free etc.

**2.1.6** As regards CSR projects in Aspirational Districts, organising eye camps including conducting cataract operation and other eye surgeries at aspirational districts Begusarai, Aurangabad, Jamui, Khagaria, Shiekhpora, Muzzafarpur, Nawada and Sitamarhi in Bihar. Training, monitoring and assessment for anganwadis and construction of four anganwadi centres at Aheri, Bhamragad, Sironcha and Gadchiroli blocks at aspirational district Gadchiroli in Maharashtra were carried out. Development of model horticulture farm at aspirational district Ramanathapuram in Tamil Nadu was done. Medical equipment was supplied to ASJSATDS medical college at aspirational district Fatehpur in Uttar Pradesh. CSR support to Raichur Institute of Medical Sciences at aspirational district Raichur in Karnataka was carried out. Contribution to Homi Bhabha Cancer Hospital & Research Centre at aspirational district Muzaffarpur in Bihar was done. Provision of smart TV in 70 schools at aspirational district Sirohi in Rajasthan was completed. Providing blood bank medical equipment to remote PHCs, construction of anganwadi centres at 4 villages, installation of 200 solar street lamps in villages at aspirational district Parvathipuram Manyam and providing medical equipment to Government Teaching General Hospital, construction of three additional class rooms at aspirational district Vizianagaram in Andhra Pradesh were carried out. In all 17 projects were carried out in 15 aspirational districts in different states.

### **3.0 Highlights/ Major achievements**

#### **3.1 Education**

##### **3.1.1 Installation of smart boards near Kaiga at Karnataka**

Smart boards and furniture were installed at various schools. This would help school children in learning computers and promote e-learning. Number of beneficiaries would be 900. Cost of this project was ₹ 143.02 lakh.



### 3.1.2 Augmentation of teachers at Kannada medium school near Kaiga at Karnataka

Augmentation of teachers at Kannada medium school located within 16 Km radius of Plant Site was done. Number of beneficiaries were 3500 and this year ₹ 104.53 lakh was spent on the project. This will reduce drop out rate.



### 3.1.3 Cycle distribution to Girl students, Tarapur at Maharashtra

Cycle distribution to needy girl students residing in surrounding area of Site were carried out. Number of beneficiaries were 200. Cost of this project was ₹ 13.05 lakh. The project will help in reducing drop out cases.



## 3.2 Skill Development

### 3.2.1 Skill development training, Kakrapar at Gujarat

Skill development training is being provided to the neighbourhood youth through CIPET, Navsari. The training was provided on plastic moulding. This year ₹ 67.23 lakh was spent on the project. Around 100 youth will be trained through this project.



### 3.2.2 Skill Development Training on sanitary pad preparation, Kakrapar at Gujarat

Skill development training on sanitary pad preparation was provided to unemployed youth. Cost of this project was ₹ 7.75 lakh. MoU with District Employment Exchange Office, Ahwa-Dang District was signed for the purpose.



## 3.3 Health Services

### 3.3.1 Medical Equipment at Raichur

Development of Paediatric ward at Raichur Institute of Medical Sciences was carried out. Raichur is an aspirational district. Cost of this project was ₹ 149.25 lakh. Number of beneficiaries for this project would be 3126569.



### **3.3.2 Supply and installation of equipment to medical college, Fatehpur, Uttar Pradesh**

Supply and installation of equipment to ASJSATDS medical college, Fatehpur was carried out. Around 370000 persons would be benefitted by this project. This year ₹ 109.24 lakh was spent on the project.



### 3.3.3 Eye Camp, Kalpakkam at Tamil Nadu

Eye camp was organised near Kalpakkam Township. The project benefitted around 2500 persons of surrounding area. Spectacles were distributed and surgeries were carried out. Cost of this project was ₹ 38.60 lakh.



### 3.3.4 RO Filtration Plant, Kalpakkam at Tamil Nadu

RO filtration plant was commissioned near Site. The project benefitted around 10000 persons of surrounding area. This year ₹ 131.54 lakh was spent on the project. The project has ensured availability of safe drinking water in nearby area.



### 3.4 Infrastructure Development

#### 3.4.1 Development of pond at village Madarchowk near Rawatbhata, Rajasthan

Development of pond at Madarchowk located in Bhainsorgarh panchayat was carried out. Number of beneficiaries would be 5000. This year ₹ 31.27 lakh was spent on the project. The project will be useful for irrigation and ensure availability of drinking water.



### 3.4.2 Installation of solar street lights near Kaiga, Karnataka

Installation of solar street lights were carried out at nearby villages of Kaiga. This year expenditure incurred on the project was ₹ 3.11 lakh. This will benefit around 650 persons of the surrounding area.



## 4.0 CSR Expenditure

The total expenditure of ₹ 154.70 Crore was incurred on the CSR programme in FY 2025-26 against the CSR fund allocation of ₹ 146.62 Crore. The details of expenditure on CSR programme in FY 2025-26 are given in the table below:

## **5.0 Unit CSR Reports**

This section consists of unit CSR reports. A total of 86 new projects and 146 on-going projects were taken up during the year by the units. The major CSR projects completed as well as under progress at different units are given in this section.

### **5.1 CSR at Tarapur Maharashtra Site (TMS)**

CSR projects were implemented in villages located within 16 Km radius from T M Site. TMS spent ₹ 1310.61 lakh from annual CSR budget of FY 2025-26. Using this fund, TMS

initiated 8 new CSR projects and also executed 12 on-going projects. Glimpses of some of the projects in 2025-26 are provided below.

#### 5.1.1 Distribution of notebooks to school students near Tarapur

Notebooks were distributed to Zila Parishad schools located within 16 Km radius of Plant Site. Number of beneficiaries were 10000 and estimated cost of this project is ₹ 90 lakh. This will reduce dropout rate.



#### 5.1.2 Skill development training near Tarapur

Skill development training is being provided to the neighbourhood youth through CIPET, Navsari. The training was provided on plastic processing and CNC lathe. Cost of this project was ₹ 232.65 lakh.



### 5.1.3 Training to differently abled children near Tarapur

Differently abled children were trained through Anubal Vikas Sanstha. The project has helped poor children residing in the surrounding area of Site. This year ₹ 39.24 lakh was spent on the project. No. of children trained were 75.



### 5.1.4 Distribution of nutrition kit to ZP School students, Tarapur

Nutrition kits were distributed to surrounding Zilla Parishad School students residing near Tarapur. Number of beneficiaries were 9000 The project was carried out through Kishore Musale Charitable Trust (KMCT), Mumbai.



### 5.1.5 Cycle distribution to Girl students near Tarapur

Cycle distribution to needy girl students residing in surrounding area of Site were carried out. Number of beneficiaries would be 200. Estimated cost of this project is ₹ 13.05 lakh. The project will help in reducing drop out cases.



### 5.1.6 Distribution of water coolers to Z P schools near Tarapur

Water coolers were distributed to 80 Zilla Parishad schools located within 16 Km radius of Plant Site. Number of beneficiaries were 10000 and cost of this project was ₹ 22.08 lakh. This will reduce dropout rate.



### 5.1.7 Assisting differently abled persons near Tarapur

Assessment camp was conducted for differently abled persons including senior citizens for providing assistive devices through ALIMCO. The project will benefit 11000 persons and this year ₹ 129.54 lakh was spent on the project.



### 5.1.8 Handing over of ambulance to PHC, Vasala near Tarapur

An ambulance was handed over to Primary Health Centre, Vasala located near Tarapur Site. Cost of this project was ₹ 65.38 lakh. The project would benefit around 19000 villagers residing within 16 Km radius of Site.



#### 5.1.9 Handing over of ambulance to PHC, Vangoan near Tarapur

An ambulance was handed over to Primary Health Centre, Vangoan located near Tarapur Site. Cost of this project was ₹ 65.38 lakh. The project would benefit around 19000 villagers residing within 16 Km radius of Site.



#### 5.1.10 Handing over of ambulance to Satpati Gram Panchayat near Tarapur

An ambulance was handed over to Satpati Gram panchayat located near Tarapur Site. Cost of this project was ₹ 65.38 lakh. The project would benefit around 19000 villagers residing within 16 Km radius of Site.



#### **5.1.11 Construction of bituminous road at village Kumbhavali near Tarapur**

Construction of bituminous and CC road at village Kumbhavali and others were carried out near Tarapur Site. This year ₹ 208.62 lakh was spent on the project. The project has benefitted 100000 persons of surrounding area.



#### **5.1.12 Construction of road at village Tarapur**

Construction of road at village Tarapur was carried out. This year ₹ 208.62 lakh was spent on the project. The project has benefitted 100000 persons of surrounding area. The project has facilitated better mobility in the nearby area.



#### 5.1.13 Cement benches near Tarapur

Cement benches were provided near schools, parks, bus stops, crematorium etc. at the surrounding area of Site. Number of beneficiaries would be 19000. Estimated cost of this project was ₹ 15 lakh.



#### 5.1.14 Installation of solar street lights near Tarapur

Solar street lights were installed at the surrounding area of Tarapur Site. Number of beneficiaries would be 113000. Estimated cost of this project was ₹ 70 lakh. This would improve mobility in the nearby areas.



## **5.2 CSR at Rawatbhata Rajasthan Site (RRS)**

RRS spent ₹ 2855.80 lakh from annual CSR budget of FY 2025-26. Using this fund, RRS prepared a CSR plan for the development of neighbourhood area located within 16 Km radius and took up 14 new CSR projects apart from executing 13 on-going projects. This year the CSR activities were undertaken in 135 no. of surrounding villages. Major CSR projects implemented at RRS are given below.

### **5.2.1 Construction of Mahatma Gandhi Government School at Bhainsorgarh near Rawatbhata**

Construction of Mahatma Gandhi Government School at Bhainsorgarh was carried out. It will benefit around 500 students. This year ₹ 37.42 lakh was spent on the project. The project will reduce dropout rate.



### 5.2.2 Providing smart TVs at aspirational district, Sirohi

Smart TVs were provided in 70 Government Schools of aspirational district Sirohi. The project has benefitted around 25000 students. This year ₹ 97.99 lakh was spent on the project. The project will reduce dropout rate.



### 5.2.3 Distribution of scholarship to talented students near Rawatbhata

Scholarships were reimbursed to talented students of Government Schools. The project has benefitted around 1700 students. This year ₹ 89.58 lakh was spent on the project. The project will reduce dropout rate.



### 5.2.4 Preparation of uniform for the students residing near Rawatbhata

Uniforms were prepared for the students of class 9, 10, 11 & 12 std. The project has benefitted around 4000 students. This year ₹ 66.21 lakh was spent on the project. The project will reduce dropout rate.



### 5.2.5 Preparation of uniform for the anganwadis residing near Rawatbhata

Uniforms were prepared for the anganwadis residing near Rawatbhata. The project has benefitted around 4240 students. This year ₹ 64.83 lakh was spent on the project. The project was implemented through self help group Anusimran.



### 5.2.6 Skill development training of tailoring/ stitching near Rawatbhata

Skill development training of tailoring/stitching was conducted near Rawatbhata. The project has benefitted 60 women. This year ₹ 44.50 lakh was spent on the project. The project was implemented through Anu Saheli.



### 5.2.7 Sponsorship of Swadeshi Mahotsav at Chittorgarh

Sponsorship of Swadeshi Mahotsav was held at Chittorgarh for upliftment of swadeshi products, micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs) & self help groups. This is for local economic development. Cost of this project was ₹ 14.99 lakh.



### 5.2.8 Providing furniture to various Government Schools near Rawatbhata

Furniture was provided to various Government schools located near Rawatbhata. Number of beneficiaries would be around 4500. This year ₹ 119.40 lakh was spent on the project. This will reduce drop out cases.



### 5.2.9 Training and education for children with special need under UDAAN project

Training for children with special need (CWSN) under UDAAN project was provided at Rawatbhata which benefitted 60 identified children of the surrounding area. This year ₹ 61.40 lakh was spent on the project.



### 5.2.10 Provision of cleaning equipment to Nagarpalika near Rawatbhata

Garbage collection and cleaning equipment was provided to Nagarpalika, Rawatbhata. Number of beneficiaries would be 25000. This year ₹ 59.37 lakh was spent on the project. This will improve sanitation facilities at the surrounding area.



### 5.2.11 Distribution of T-Shirts on Yoga day near Rawatbhata

T-Shirts of assorted size were distributed to persons residing near Rawatbhata on Yoga day celebration. Number of beneficiaries were 1000 Cost of this project was ₹ 1.65 lakh. Encouragement of Yoga is beneficial to the society.



### 5.2.12 Organizing health check-up camps near Rawatbhata

Health check-up camps were organized at Rawatbhata, Shripura and Mandesara villages. Number of beneficiaries were 2000. Cost of this project was ₹ 83.13 lakh. This has improved availability of medical facilities at the surrounding area.



### 5.2.13 Construction of Anganwadi Centres near Rawatbhata

Anganwadi centres at Bhainsorgarh, Mandesara, Thamlav, Banjara Basti, Kolpura and Parajhar Khurd were constructed near Rawatbhata. Number of beneficiaries would be 250. This year ₹ 60.98 lakh was spent on the project.



### 5.2.14 Construction of 6 MLD water treatment plant near Rawatbhata

6 MLD water treatment/filtration plant is under construction for Rawatbhata town. Number of beneficiaries would be 67000. This year ₹ 287.41 lakh was spent on the project. The project will ensure availability of safe drinking water.



#### **5.2.15 Construction of footpath and internal concrete road near Rawatbhata**

Infrastructure development work pertaining to footpath and internal concrete road was carried out at the surrounding villages of Site. This year expenditure incurred on the project was ₹ 889.12 lakh which would benefit around 25000 persons.

40000 canvas bags were prepared and distributed for making Rawatbhata Nagar Palika area polythene free. This year ₹ 52.56 lakh has been spent on the project. The project has improved environmental sustainability.



### 5.3 CSR at Madras Atomic Power Station (MAPS)

### 5.3.3 Construction of Panchayat Union Primary School building at Valavanthangal near Kalpakkam

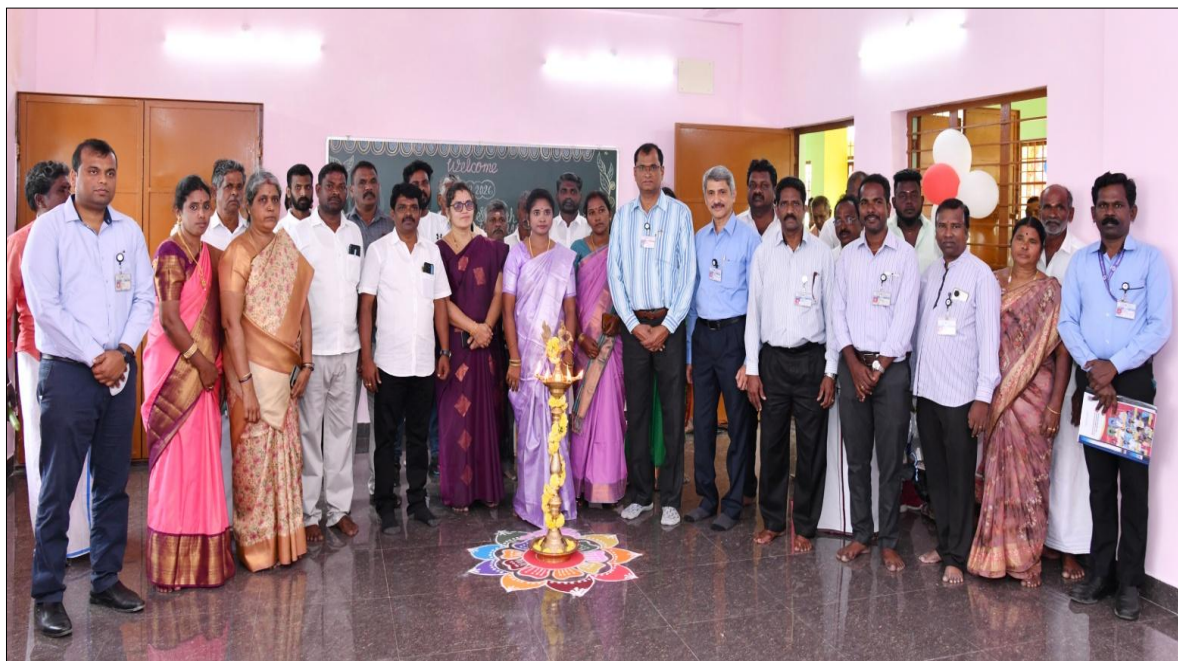

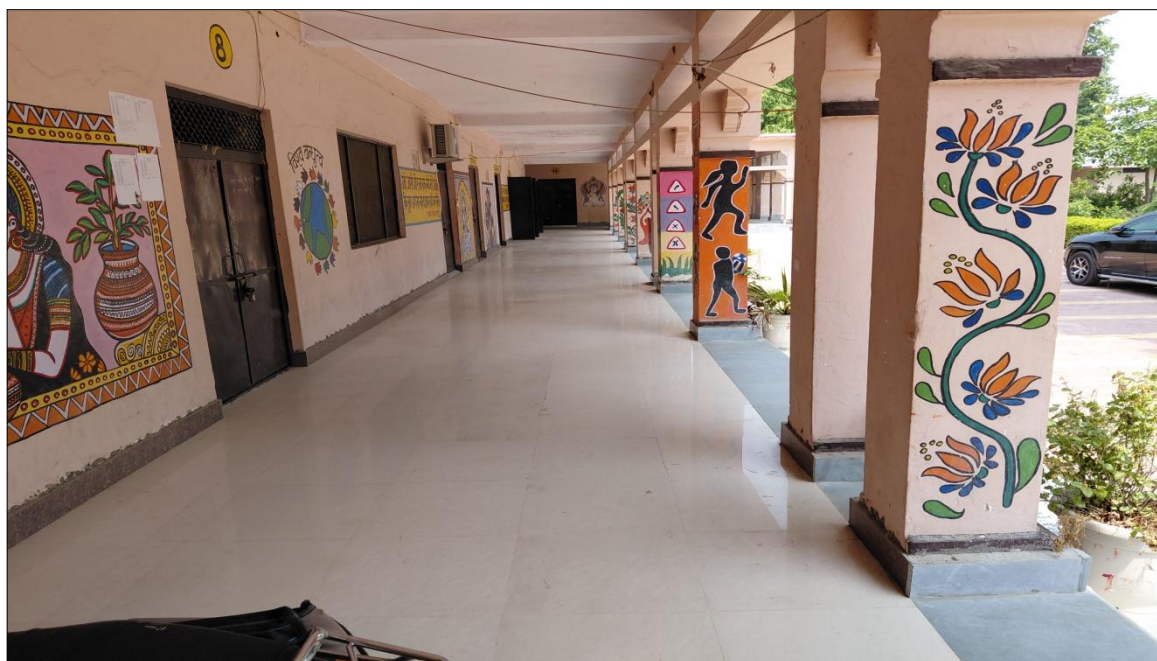

NPCIL was conferred with Social Impact Award at India for Bharat Conclave 2025 organized by Akhand Jyoti Eye Hospital. The award was presented by Shri Hardeep Singh Puri, Minister for Petroleum and Gas.



#### 5.4.12 TB elimination program near Narora

The TB elimination is an ambitious project of the Government of India to improve the health parameters of the country and make the lives of its citizen better and healthy. 7593 nutritional support kits were distributed to villagers residing in nearby area of Site.



#### 5.4.13 Supply and installation of equipment to medical college, Fatehpur

Supply and installation of equipment to ASJSATDS medical college, Fatehpur was carried out. Around 370000 persons would be benefitted by this project. This year ₹ 109.24 lakh was spent on the project.



#### **5.4.14 Eye treatment at aspirational districts of Bihar by Narora Site**

Eye treatment at 8 aspirational districts of Bihar was carried out by Narora Site. The project has helped poor people residing at aspirational districts of Bihar. Estimated cost of this project is ₹ 500 lakh and number of beneficiaries were around 8000



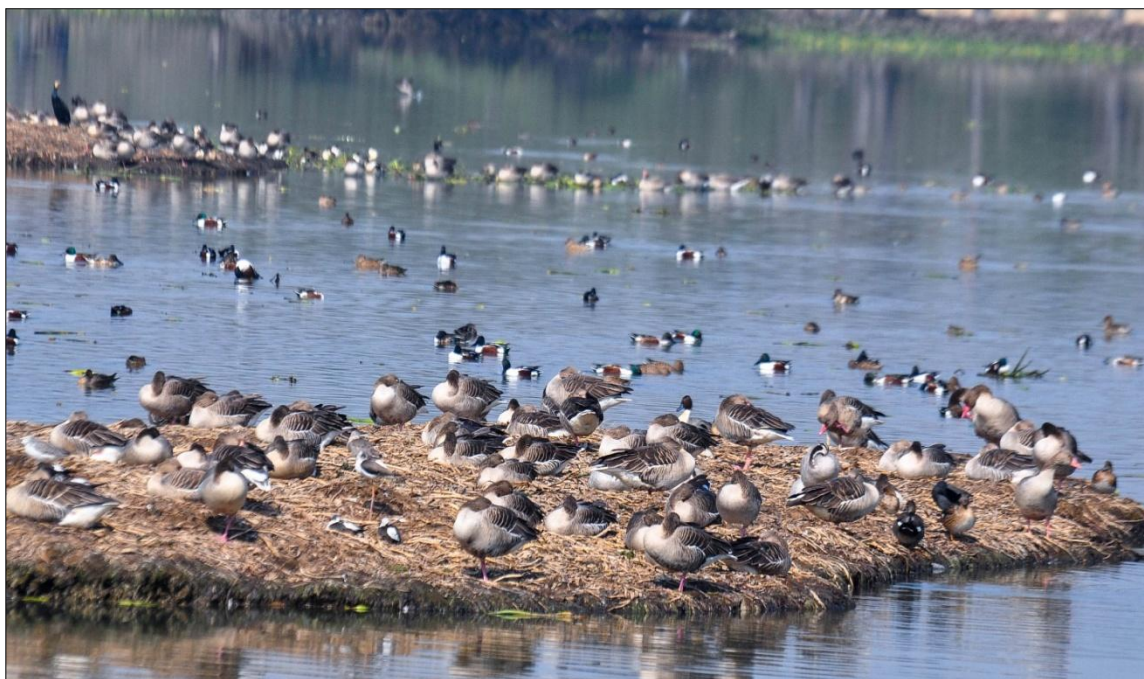
#### **5.4.15 Construction of bitumen road between Ramghat and Gokulpur near Narora**

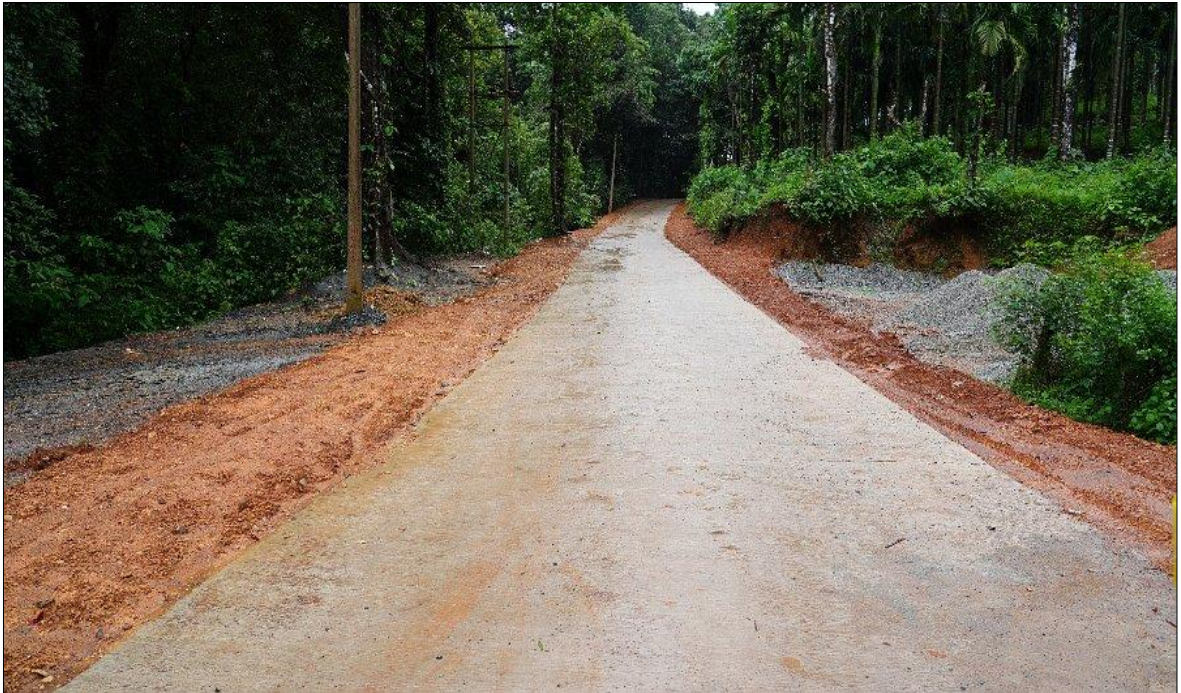
#### 5.6.7 Medical Equipment at Raichur

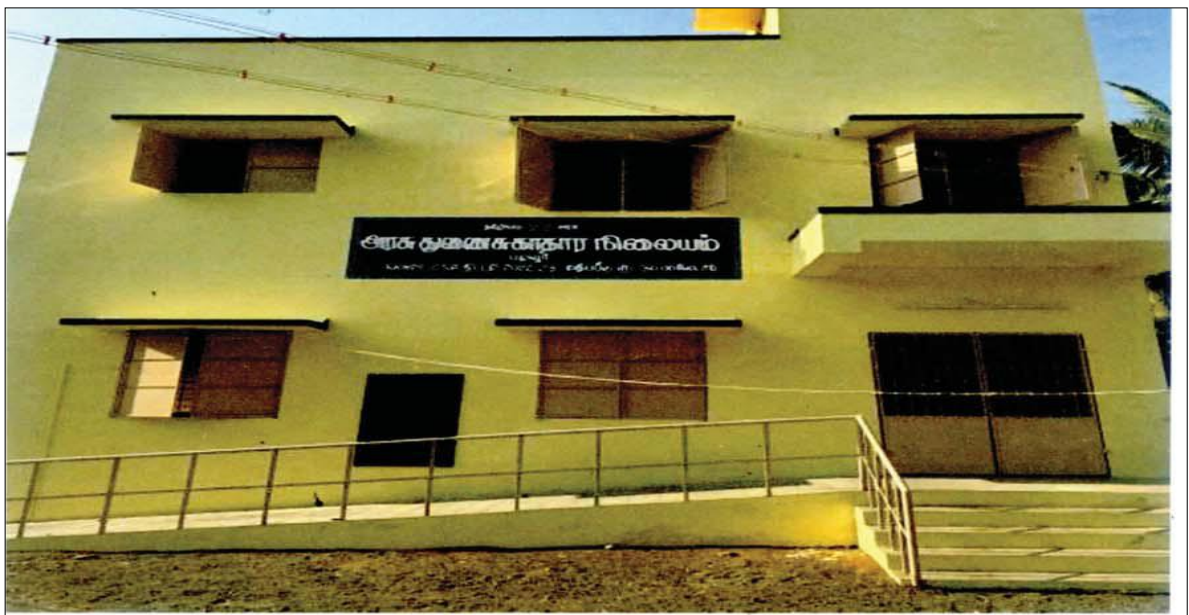

Mobile medical van services with a team of doctors and nurse were put into services for villages around Gorakhpur Site. Number of beneficiaries are around 55000 persons residing in that area. This year ₹ 66.94 lakh was spent on the project.



#### 5.8.8 Mobile Medical Van for villages around Township near Gorakhpur

Mobile medical van services with a team of doctors and nurse were put into services for villages around Township. Number of beneficiaries are around 60000 persons residing in that area. This year ₹ 66.94 lakh was spent on the project.



#### 5.8.9 Equipment for testing of TB patients near Gorakhpur

Equipments for testing of TB patients were procured for the benefit of surrounding villagers. Cost of this project was ₹ 170.40 lakh. There is increase in number of TB patients by 8.9% in Haryana state.



#### **5.8.10 Laying of sewer line at village Siwani Bolan near Gorakhpur**

Laying of sewer line at village Siwani Bolan located near Gorakhpur Site was carried out. Number of beneficiaries would be around 36000 persons residing in that area. This year ₹ 85.07 lakh was spent on the project.



#### **5.8.11 Laying of pipeline at village Kuleri near Gorakhpur**

Laying of pipeline at village Kuleri located near Gorakhpur Site was carried out. Number of beneficiaries would be around 36000 persons residing in that area. This year ₹ 85.07 lakh was spent on the project.



#### **5.8.12 Underground water tank at Kirmara near Gorakhpur**

Underground water tank was constructed at village Kirmara located near Gorakhpur Site. Number of beneficiaries would be around 36000 persons residing in that area. This year ₹ 85.07 lakh was spent on the project.



#### 5.8.13 Construction of firni road near Gorakhpur

Construction of road around Sabarwas, Kumharia and Gorakhpur of appoximately 18 Km length is being constructed. This year ₹ 724.39 lakh was spent on the project. Around 338000 persons will be benefitted by this project.



#### 5.8.14 Construction of bus stop at Jandli Khurd near Gorakhpur

Construction of 17 bus stops were carried out near Gorakhpur Site. This year ₹ 19.64 lakh was spent on the project. Around 137110 persons will be benefitted by this project. The project has improved availability of infrastructure facilities in the surrounding area.



#### 5.8.15 Mobile Medical Van near Chutka

Mobile medical van 2 nos. with a team of doctors and nurse were put into services for villages around Chutka Site. This year the project has benefitted around 35000 persons residing in that area. Around ₹ 84 lakh was spent on this project.



#### 5.8.16 Transport facility for villagers near Chutka

Transport facility (one bus) was provided for surrounding project affected persons. The bus is running from village Chutka to District Mandla via Narayanganj and back. The bus is being run by M/s Gautam Infra.



### 5.8.17 Food baskets for TB patients near Chutka

Distribution of food baskets to TB patients were done during Adi Utsav at village Ramnagar. So far ₹ 31.50 lakh has been spent on this project. The project has benefitted 700 persons of the surrounding area.



### 5.8.18 New pedagogy based laboratories in Government Schools near Chutka

74 Bala paintings, 12 Tinker labs., 37 Stem labs. and 11 astronomical labs. were set up in surrounding area of village Chutka that focus on creative and technical skills. No. of beneficiaries of this project would be 50000.



#### 5.8.19 Improvement in learning through technological interventions near, Banswara

Improvement in learning outcome in Government Schools located near Site through various technological interventions was carried out. This year ₹ 67.62 lakh has been spent on the project. This will benefit around 100000 students.



#### 5.8.20 Construction of School building at village near Banswara

Construction of Sajwaniya Government Middle School was carried out. Cost of this project was ₹ 231.20 lakh and it will benefit around 400 students. This will reduce dropout rate. The project will improve education facilities in the surrounding area.



#### **5.8.21 Construction of 2 nos. of auditorium with library near Banswara**

Construction of 2 nos. of auditorium with library was carried out at Government Senior Secondary School located near Banswara Site. This year ₹ 116.42 lakh was spent on the project. This will benefit around 10000 students and improve quality of education.



#### **5.8.22 Construction of Gym hall with equipments at Banswara**

Construction of Gym hall with equipments, sports equipment hall in district stadium premises at Banswara was carried out. This year expenditure incurred on this project was ₹ 43.79 lakh. This will benefit persons of the surrounding area.



#### 5.8.23 Medical equipment to GGH, Srikakulam

Medical equipment was supplied to Government General Hospital (GGH), Srikakulam. This project will boost availability of medical facilities at district Srikakulam. Cost of project was ₹ 110.78 lakh. Number of beneficiaries would be around 116301.



#### 5.8.24 Medical equipment to GTGH, Vizianagaram

Medical equipment was supplied to Government Teaching General Hospital (GTGH), Vizianagaram. Cost of this project was ₹ 99.46 lakh. Number of beneficiaries would be around 371605.



#### 5.8.25 Medical equipment to aspirational district Parvathipuram Manyam

Blood bank medical equipment (HB electrophoresis machines) were supplied to the remote PHCs of aspirational district Parvathipuram Manyam. Cost of this project was ₹ 93.12 lakh. Number of beneficiaries would be around 766157.



#### 5.8.26 Distribution of Cycles to girl students near Jaitapur

Distribution of cycles, bicycle air pump, water coolers, R O purifiers, benches, cupboards, white boards etc. were carried out at schools located near Jaitapur Site. Cost of this project was ₹ 60.27 lakh. Number of beneficiaries were 1694



#### **5.8.27 Construction of asphalt road at village Mithgavane near Jaitapur**

Construction of asphalt road from Shivaji Chowk Mithgavane to Shri Anjaneshwara Temple at village Mithgavane was carried out near Jaitapur. Estimated cost of this project was ₹ 25 lakh. Number of beneficiaries would be around 1992.



#### **5.8.28 Construction of Cement Concrete road at village Karel near Jaitapur**

Construction of Cement Concrete internal road at village Karel near Jaitapur Site was completed. Cost of this project was ₹ 190.36 lakh. Number of beneficiaries would be around 200. The project has improved mobility in the surrounding area.



#### **6.0 Monitoring**

The Tier-II Committee on CSR as well as Board Sub-Committee for CSR regularly monitor progress of CSR programme and the expenditure incurred.

#### **7.0 Result/Impact**

CSR teams and senior executives interact with the local population to understand their requirements of educational, medical and infrastructure facilities. Because of this the locals are now more open to request facilities they need. Projects for sustainability have been integrated in the CSR programme. Skill development initiatives are being emphasized to help the village people generate income.

#### **8.0 Conclusion**

NPCIL is fully complying with the provisions of section 135 of Companies Act, 2013 for implementation of CSR program. Execution of CSR projects is being done by the sites.
