**Activities carried out under Category A for the month of November, 2021**

1. As a part of the celebrations of the Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsava, a tree plantation activity was organized wherein CMD, NPCIL along with all the Directors and the Executive Directors planted trees in the lawn area of Nabhakiya Urja Bhavan (NUB) at the NPCIL HQ Office, Mumbai to give a message that NPCIL cares for the environment and also to keep the nature green and pollution free.

Also a book collection drive, inaugurated by CMD, NPCIL and all the Directors and Executive Directors was organized in which hundreds of books were collected and distributed to the less privileged and the needy children. By this activity NPCIL wanted to share the light of knowledge along with the production of electricity in the 75<sup>th</sup> year of Indian Independence.

Also NPCIL was a part of the centenary celebrations of HBTI Kanpur as a part of its contribution in reaching out to maximum students and make them aware of the saga of DAE and the contribution of Atomic Energy in the development of the nation. This was done by means of organizing a webinar on Nuclear Power Plant Technology for the students of HBTI Kanpur.
4. To celebrate Indian Independence and highlight the contributions of Atomic Energy in the development of the nation, NPCIL organized quiz for various colleges and also felicitated the winners.
5. NPCIL is finding many innovative ways to make the employees feel proud to be a part of DAE and celebrate India's 75<sup>th</sup> year of independence. Among these, NPCIL has announced a short film competition for its employees on the theme "Contribution of NPCIL in the nation building" with attractive prizes for the winners.
