FOR THE POST OF ASSISTANT GRADE -1 AND STENO GRADE -1**

The written examinations scheduled on 27.05.2018, 29.05.2018, 31.05.2018, 01.06.2018 and 02.06.2018 were postponed and the same are **now rescheduled** as per the following dates.

The above revised dates have also been communicated to the candidates separately through letter, e-mail and SMS provided in their application. Details of instructions of candidates and other information is attached herewith.

Senior Manager (HRM)

Instructions to the candidates:

- ☞ The candidate is admitted to the written examination provisionally based on the age criteria and the educational qualification as furnished by him / her in the application. The detailed scrutiny of the eligibility of the candidate would be done only at the final stage of the recruitment process and as such, the candidature of the applicant shall remain provisional till completion of the recruitment process in all respects.
- ☞ NPCIL, KKNPP would be at liberty to reject any application at any stage of the recruitment process, if the candidate is found ineligible for the post or if it comes to notice that the candidate has furnished false information. The decision of KKNPP is final in deciding the eligibility of the candidate.
- ☞ The mere fact that a call letter has been issued to the candidate and allowed to appear in a written examination & subsequent process of selection will not imply that his/her candidature has been finally cleared or that entries made by the candidate in his/her application have been accepted as true and correct.

Travelling allowance for Persons with Disabilities (PWD) Candidates, SC/ST:

- ☞ Travelling Allowance equivalent to 2nd class Rail Fare or Bus fare by shortest route will be paid to the candidates beyond 30 kms as per rules. Copy of valid PWD Certificate, SC/ST caste certificate, Journey tickets and ticket numbers should be produced for claiming Travelling Allowance. Travelling expenditure shall not be reimbursed to candidates for attending written test if they do not fulfill the eligibility criteria or do not produce documents like Caste Certificate, PWD Certificate if applicable and travelling tickets etc.
- ☞ SC/ST, PWD Candidates who appear for the written examination has to produce all the ticket(s) from the place of commencement of journey till reaching the examination venue for availing Travelling Allowance. It may be noted that, Travelling Allowance will be restricted to the travel from correspondence address. However, PWD candidates, SC/ST those who are already employed in service of Central/State Government, Central/State Corporations, PSUs, Local Government Institutions and Panchayats, shall not be paid travelling allowance.

Instructions for Land losers of KKNPP:

- ☞ Candidates who are claiming the status of Land losers of KKNPP must have a valid Employment Preference Certificate (Land Loser Certificate) indicating the applicants' names against Legal heir issued by the Competent Authority subject to verification by KKNPP. Decision of KKNPP shall be final.
- ☞ Candidates, whose names are mentioned in the Employment Preference Certificate at Sl.No. 8 (நிலம் சொந்தக்காரரின் வாரிசுப் பட்டியல்) but not mentioned as legal heir against Sl.No.10 of the Certificate (இந்த சான்று பெறுபவர் நிலச் சொந்தக்காரர் (அ) அவர் வாரிசு மற்றும் உறவுமுறை) shall provide a No Objection Certificate for employment from the legal heir in a Non-judicial stamp paper for Rs. 100/- duly attested by Notary Public in original, wherever applicable at the time of appointment.
- ☞ Candidates who have applied under Land Loser Category are required to submit an Undertaking that none of their family members have got employment using this Employment Preference Certificate from any other organization including NPCIL.

General Instructions:

- ☞ Candidates should affix recent passport size photograph and signature may be appended on top of the photograph in the space provided on the Admit Card in such a way that half portion of the signature should appear on the application form and the remaining on the photograph. If any candidate comes without affixing the photograph, they will not be admitted for the Written Test.
- ☞ The candidate shall appear for the Written Examination at the centre on the date and time specified.
- ☞ Candidates should bring the following items at the time of appearing for the examination:
 - ◆ Duly filled and signed Admit Card.
 - ◆ Ball Pen (Black Ink) only to be used for shading the answers in OMR Sheet.
 - ◆ Valid Photo ID Proof,
- ☞ As per directives of Govt. of India, only those OBC candidates who have Non Creamy Layer Certificate are eligible for reservation. Hence latest OBC (Non Creamy Layer) Certificate should be produced at the time of written examination to avail OBC benefits. Otherwise they will be treated as General Category subject to fulfilling eligible criteria for General category.
- ☞ Candidates should report at 0830 hrs. at the exam centre.
- ☞ Candidates are not allowed to carry any textual material, printed or written bits of paper, mobile phone, electronic device, logarithms table, slide ruler, calculator or any other material/gadgets inside the examination hall.
- ☞ Admit Card shall be handed over to the Invigilator at the Examination Hall. The Identity Slip can be retained by the candidate for future reference.

- ☞ If any candidate is found to be committing malpractice, he/she will be disqualified and in addition will be subject to penal action.
- ☞ Candidates are not allowed to enter the examination hall after half an hour from the commencement of examination and not allowed to leave the examination hall upto one hour from the commencement of exam.
- ☞ The list of candidates who are qualified in the written examination and short listed for Typing Test on PC, Computer Literacy Test will be displayed in the exam centre on the same day. Typing Test on PC, Computer Literacy Test will be conducted on the following days of written examination. **Hence Candidates may have to make their own arrangement for stay.**
- ☞ No other correspondence shall be entertained. Date of examination and venue shall not be changed.
- ☞ KKNPP will not be responsible for any delay or non-delivery of this Admit Card.
- ☞ This letter does not constitute an offer of employment.
- ☞ Canvassing/ Recommendations in any form shall be a disqualification.

Instructions for filling up OMR Sheet

1. The written examination papers consist of objective type questions.
2. No negative mark will be awarded for wrong answers.
3. Instructions for filling the OMR answer sheet:-
 - a. Use Ball Point Pen (Black Ink) to fill in the boxes and to blacken the appropriate circles (as answers).
 - b. Each question will have four suggested answers as choice (A), (B), (C) & (D).
 - c. For example, if the answer to question No. 2 is C, circle C has to be blackened as shown below.
 - d. Only one answer has to be selected and blackened. More than one response for the same question will be treated as wrong answer.
 - e. Complete shading of circle has to be done. Partial shading will be treated as wrong answer.
4. Candidate should not leave the Examination Hall without handing over their original OMR/Answer Sheet along with Question Booklet, Admit card and rough sheets to the Invigilator on duty in the Room/hall and they should sign the Attendance Sheet.
